Health and Hygiene Policy

Good personal health and hygiene practices are common sense, and they help reduce the chance of spreading human and plant diseases on our farm, and to our customers. Below are the essential personal practices that we all agree to follow to reduce risk and stay healthy:

- **WASHING HANDS:** We **thoroughly wash our hands**, after going to the bathroom, before returning to work, or as needed.
- **SICK POLICY:** If we are sick, we attempt to take care of ourselves and rest to get better quick. If we are sick with symptoms of an **infectious disease** (i.e. fever, vomiting, diarrhea, and jaundice), we **do not** handle raw-eaten produce. Workers should always contact a supervisor if sick, and decided the best course of action.
- **FIRST AID:** We **quickly treat cuts, abrasions**, and other injuries, and report them. Bleeding is stopped, covered and protected before continuing work.
